











DRUG OF CHOICE BY REGION – ADOLESCENTS ADMITTED JULY 2017









(ADULT/OLDER ADULT) - MONTHLY UNIQUE VISITS @ EMERGENCY PSYCHIATRIC UNIT





(CHILDREN YOUTH & FAMILIES) - MONTHLY UNIQUE CLIENTS @ EMERGENCY SCREENING UNIT







(CHILDREN YOUTH & FAMILIES) - MONTHLY UNDUPLICATED CLIENTS @ FFS HOSPITALS





(ADULT/OLDER ADULT) - READMISSIONS WITHIN 30 DAYS @ FFS HOSPITALS





(CHILDREN YOUTH & FAMILIES) - READMISSIONS WITHIN 30 DAYS @ FFS HOSPITALS





(ADULT/OLDER ADULT) - INVOLUNTARY PATIENTS @ EMERGENCY PSYCHIATRIC UNIT












